The first World Boomerang Championships were **T**HELD in Australia in 1988. There are several types of boomerang events that are included **G**IN the competitions:

Fast Catch: A time-trial competition to achieve¹ **F**AST**H**EST time for five catches.

Trick Catch: Players are judged on tricks like catching behind back, or **B**IET**W**EEN legs.

Long Distance: A competition to **F**I**U**ND the longest **T**HROWN.

Juggling: Consecutive² catches test with two boomerangs.

In all events, players compete individually³, and all throws have to **T**RAN**V**EL at least 20m to be considered as a valid⁴ throw.
